



Seeking to deepen my relationship with each other at Church:

These and other scriptures urge us to encourage each other, build one another up, have concern for one another. Pray for each other etc. Consider them:

Galatians 6:1-10; 5:13-15. Philippians 2:1-18. Ephesians 5:15-21
Romans 15:7; 1 Thess. 5:11; James 5:13-20 Ephesians 4:1-32
1 Corinthians 12:12-26

Consider inviting someone who is on their own or a couple for a coffee/tea, light supper, meal or just an informal social?

If they can't get to you, consider meeting with them. If not in their home it could even be a quiet corner of the George Hotel or similar place.

Talk to each other:

What do you do?

What are your interests? – What do you like doing?

What do you miss most?

Are there family concerns

How do you cope?

What would you like to do?

Share together something of where each other is at in their relationship with God. Are there any particular worries or issues that need to be faced this coming week. Pray for each other.

Discover other needs and concerns so that you can pray for each other. When praying be bold to ask God to heal, restore, bless – whatever the need may be. Pray believing. James 1:5-8.

Share the bible together.

Check out some of the above references and determine to live by them.

Share what God has been revealing to you in recent days.

As we share with each other at a deeper level so trust and confidence develops and we find a growing accountability before God as someone else opens their heart to us. This is a real privilege and part of what the local church should be about. Let us plead to God for them – making sure every confidentiality is strictly kept.

This will be great practice as we have opportunity to engage with people who are friends and neighbours, colleagues and part of our community.
